USED project – interview format

The interview will cover the 3 sections outlined below. Interviewer should try not to rattle through the questions, rather it should be a conversation with the bullet points below as a guide to the possible flow.

Section 1 – who they are

- **About them** who/interests/life general
- About their work/study what/where/how long/
- Motivation plans?
- Where do you work/study? Library/office/lab/home
 - What do you tend to have around you, is there a desk, laptop/PC/mobile phone etc?
- What kind of computer/tech do you use?
 - Smart Phone/laptop/desktop
 - o Frequency of use
- Use of internet
 - o for work/study?
 - o Reading news
 - o Buying stuff
 - banking

Section 2 – mapping and geographical services

- Is mapping relevant to your work/study/research?
- Do you use maps outside of work much?
- What online mapping services do you use? (google/bing/osm/Digimap ROAM/Carto)
 - O How often might you use that/those services?
 - O How easy do you find them to use?
 - O Do they allow you to do what you need to do?
 - O What do you tend to do when you use these services?
 - Try and ascertain if they understand difference between viewing map data online and accessing/using map data.

- If they use data, what do you use data for? background mapping/analysis in GIS
 - o Easy to access geo data?
 - o Problems encountered
 - o Categorising map data...
 - What kind of data would you download? (raster/vector, shapefile/kml/gml)
 - What types of mapping data can you identify? Looking to start to build a categorisation, possible words: topographic, contour, small scale, height, administrative, etc.

Section 3 – Digimap Data Download

- How did you find out about Digimap?
- What do you use Digimap for?
- Have you used downloaded data from Digimap?
 - o If not, why?
 - o If yes,
 - What did you download
 - was it easy to use
 - did you get what you wanted
 - Why/motivation/could you get the data elsewhere?
 - How often do you use it? Weekly/monthly)

Section 4 - Demo use

- Get user to show you how they use Download Services if they have used it before.
 - How would they ideally specify what data they want, e.g. draw an area on a map,
 type in a place name/postcode/select a data product?
